#### 1. Background

#### 2. Objectives

- Redesign NISH's digital platforms with a modern, user-friendly, mobile-first design.
- Ensure WCAG 2.1 accessibility compliance and alignment with GIGW (Government of India Guidelines for Websites).
- Provide multilingual support (English and Malayalam).
- Strengthen security, performance, and content management.
- Revive AccessHub as a national disability knowledge hub with advanced accessibility-first features.

### 3. Scope of Work

### A. Common to All Platforms

- Responsive design (desktop, tablet, mobile)
- Accessibility features (screen readers, contrast toggle, font resizing, ISL support)
- · Centralized CMS with role-based access control
- · SEO optimization and analytics integration
- Strong security measures (SSL/TLS, firewall, backup, intrusion detection)

- Programs, departments, research, events, media gallery, integration of online payments.
- · Announcements, news updates, social media integration
- · Easy admin panel for content editors

## 2. Malayalam Website (ml.nish.ac.in)

- Integrated language toggle for English/Malayalam

## 3. Admissions Portal (admissions.nish.ac.in)

- Candidate registration and online application submission with online payment integration
- · Administrator / Staff / Candidate login/dashboard
- · Notifications, admit card download, application status tracking
- Integration with academic systems (future-ready)

- Technical proposal quality (architecture, CMS choice, scalability).
