Centralized software platform for Farm Machinery Clinics

These Clinics will provide year-round repair and maintenance support for agricultural machinery, thereby benefiting farmers across Kerala. In this context, the department proposes to implement a centralized software platform to streamline the operations and services of the Farm Machinery Clinics.

The key requirements of the software platform are as follows:

- 1. Online advance repair booking system
- 2. Job card generation with machine diagnostics
- 3. Invoice and bill tracking
- 4. Live repair status dashboard for internal and public access
- 5. Service workflow tracking
- 6. Integration with departmental systems (e.g., AIMS, SMAM : registration database, etc.)
- 7. Spare parts inventory module recording issue, stock, and procurement needs
- 8. Regional-level monitoring and reporting tools

The software is to be developed and deployed in coordination with the Research Testing and Training (RTT) Centre, Vellayani.
