EOI FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF AI- BASED MENTORSHIP PORTAL FOR KSUM

Overview

Kerala Startup Mission (KSUM), the nodal agency of the Government of Kerala for entrepreneurship development and incubation activities in the State, is inviting Expressions of Interest (EoI) from reputed and qualified firms for the **design**, **development**, **deployment**, **and maintenance of an AI-enabled Mentor Portal** for KSUM.

The proposed Mentor Portal aims to create a unified digital platform to facilitate structured mentorship activities across Kerala's startup ecosystem. The portal will enable effective mentor–mentee matchmaking, engagement tracking, program management, scheduling, feedback & review, reporting, event integration, and performance analytics to strengthen and scale Kerala's mentorship ecosystem.

Objective

The Mentor Portal aims to:

- Provide a scalable and secure platform for connecting mentors and startups.
- Enable seamless registration, verification, and categorization of mentors and mentees.
- Facilitate mentorship session scheduling (virtual and physical).
- Streamline feedback collection, ratings, and analytics.
- Scheduling Mentorship Events time to time
- Integrate with existing KSUM systems for data synchronization and ecosystem coherence.

Scope of Work

The selected agency will be responsible for:

- Designing Mentor and mentee user registration and role-based login.
- Detailed profile creation and management with fields including expertise, experience, and document uploads.

- Advanced mentor discovery with filtering by skills, domain, and availability.
- Integrating communication tools (chat, meeting scheduler, notification systems).
- Scheduling system integrated with notification alerts and calendar sync.
- Interactive feedback, rating, and review modules.
- Dashboard for mentors, mentees, and administrators for program tracking and communication.
- Developing dashboards, analytics, and reporting modules.
- Secure integration of payment gateways if required for paid mentorship programs.
- Ensuring data security, scalability, and integration with existing KSUM systems.
- Providing documentation, user training, and ongoing support.
- Periodical malware scans.
- Fixing of issues reported.
- Providing technical support to the Security auditing and penetration testing agency for the smooth conduct of the activity during the AMC period.

Phased Development Plan

The development will follow a **three phase approach** as outlined below:

Phase 1 – Core Platform (Target Completion: March 2026)

- Admin panel and dashboard

- Basic analytics and reporting
- Security framework and data backup setup
- Go-live version for public access and beta testing

Phase 2 – Ecosystem Expansion (July 2026)

- Testimonial and storyboard publishing modules
- Knowledge bank and learning resources
- Virtual badge system and gamification
- Sector and function-wise reporting tools
- Integration with KSUM event modules (MIND, Mentor Talks, WE Grow)

- Advanced AI recommendations for mentor-startup pairing
- Mobile app version (Android & iOS)
- Reverse mentorship and corporate/investor access
- Predictive analytics dashboard and heatmaps
- API integration with other KSUM systems and partner platforms

Maintenance of WebPortal.

The Agency shall provide an Annual Maintenance service for the web portal for 3 years. During the maintenance period, the following are the activities of the contractor.

- 1. Day to day Monitoring and Maintenance and upkeep of website and CMS.
- 2. Coordination with the hosting provider for all hosting-related activities.
- 3. Provide hosting-related technical support for the website and CMS.
- 4. Proper Data Backup (including DB) and security of the website. A data backup schedule shall be prepared and followed.
- 5. Content modification/ New content addition.
- 6. Addition of new features, if any.
- 7. Incorporate design/layout changes.
- 8. To fix vulnerabilities during security audit or noticed by KSUM or informed by CERT or testing and certification organization.
- 9. Patching up all vulnerabilities during the security audit of the website.
- 10. To protect the website from hacking, malware & Damp; viruses. In case of a virus attack or hacking, the service provider shall have to resolve the issue and live/ restore the website with all functionalities and contents within 24 hours.

- 11. To keep backup in a suitable storage media containing the website CMS/content/source code/ database and provide Technopark after completion of each quarter and any stage updating of the website.
- 12. The service provider should address website performance issues like no response, slow response, downtime, crashing, etc.
- 13. 24/7 Monitoring of website (URL) and Production Server (Health status: CPU Load / Disk usage /Memory Usage / Uptime/port status, etc.).
- 14. Periodical malware scans.
- 15. Fixing of issues reported.
- 16. Providing technical support to the Security auditing and penetration testing agency for the smooth conduct of the activity.
- 17. The Agency shall follow the instructions of KSUM

Payment Terms:

KSUM shall pay the Vendor from time to time in installments. The payable schedule is as per the Government order.

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

If KSUM is not satisfied with the performance of the contract during AMC, the contract will be terminated after giving 1(One) month's prior notice to the contractor/ agency.
